Divine Mercy Chaplet for the Sick and the Dying

Jesus is quoted in St. Faustina's Diary as saying:

Pray as much as you can for the dying. By your prayers obtain for them trust in My mercy, because they have most need of trust, and have it the least. Be assured that the grace of eternal salvation for certain souls in their final moment depends on your prayer. You know the whole abyss of My mercy, so draw upon it for yourself and especially for poor sinners. Sooner would heaven and earth turn into nothingness than would My mercy not embrace a trusting soul.

Diary, 1777

The Divine Mercy Chaplet is one of the best means of assisting the dying. Jesus revealed the power of this prayer to St. Faustina, insisting that she use it often even continuously. He told her:

My daughter encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given to you. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me by saying the chaplet.... Write that when they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge, but as the merciful Savior. Diary, 1541

Earlier, Our Lord said to her: Diary 811

At the hour of their death, I defend as My own glory every soul that will say this chaplet; or when others say it for the dying person, the indulgence is the same. When this chaplet is said by the bedside of a dying person, divine wrath is placated, unfathomable mercy envelopes the soul, and the very depths of My tender mercy are moved for the sake of the sorrowful Passion of My Son.

St. Faustina comments: "Oh, if only everyone realized how great the Lord's mercy is and how much we all need that mercy, especially at that crucial hour".

When possible we will visit and pray the Chaplet on site, or we will add their name to our prayer list.
